

the historical heritage unique to the Gold Country Mountain Lodges. We are blessed to meet in the oldest continuously operating Masonic Lodge Building and Lodge Room in the entire state of Colorado. I hope that each of you shares the immense pride we have in our Central Lodge No. 6.
