Come celebrate 160 years of Freemasonry in the Gold Country of Colorado – historic Central City! Central #6 will be holding a special open communication on the afternoon of Saturday, August 27, 2022 at Central #6. We will start about noon that day and dress is “mountain casual” – boots

and jeans! Ladies are invited to join us in this historic event. No lunch, but we will have home-made ice cream and lemonade refreshments.

Most Worshipful Grand Master Ray Dunn and many of his Grand Lodge Officers will be joining us that day for presentation of 25-, 50- and 60-year awards to Brothers of the Gold Country Mountain Lodges - Central #6, Nevada #4, Idaho Springs #26, Black Hawk #11 and Georgetown #12.
